Doxycycline

Indication(s): Cellulitis (Suspected MRSA)

Contraindications: Hypersensitivity to doxycycline or other tetracyclines. Do not use in the 2nd and 3rd trimesters of pregnancy.

Precautions: Weigh risk vs benefit in children under 8 years old (risk of teeth staining).

Drug Interactions: Antacids/Food/Milk – Give 2hrs before or after (Chelation). Concurrent use of Pepto-Bismol can \downarrow doxycycline's absorption (Avoid).

Adverse Effects: (>1%) Nausea; vomiting; diarrhea; light-headedness; dizziness, vertigo, ataxia, drowsiness; fatigue; candidiasis; vaginitis. (≤1%) Rash.

Pharmacology: Inhibition of bacterial protein synthesis.

Dosage and Administration: Doxycycline 100mg PO BID for 10 days.
