Dental Pain

Signs and Symptoms:

- 1. Intermittent or continuous pain (usually intense), heat or cold sensitivity
- 2. Visibly broken / cracked tooth
- 3. Severe pain on percussion
- 4. Intraoral swelling / abscess
- 5. Partially erupted wisdom tooth


Contraindications:

Allergy to an indicated medication(s).

Management:

1. Initiate therapy as per Figure 1 – Dental Pain Flowchart.

Disposition:

1. For all of the above, consider consultation with a Dental Officer.
